PROGRAM GUIDE

Pay As You Throw (**PAYT**) is a new more equitable system that charges residents for trash disposal based on the amount they throw away rather than on the value of their property.

This program was approved by the citizens of Unity at Town Meeting on March 15, 2008.

The **FEE**s were established by the Board of Selectman after a Public Hearing on June 23rd, 2008 and will take effect August 1, 2008.

ALL recyclable containers must be rinsed clean. Transfer Station Attendants reserve the right not to accept dirty containers for recycling.

RULES OF THE ROAD

- 1. **ALL** waste must be in a special bag or it will not be accepted.
- 2. **FEE**s must be paid for large items or they will not be accepted.
- 3. Each 33 gallon bag (at this time) cost \$1.50 each.
- 4. ALL bags will be sold in packs of 10 (ten).

How PAYT Works!

- Residents purchase special bags for for their household solid waste. The special bags will have a distinct color and marking.
- 2. Recycling is FREE.
- The revenue from the sale of the bags pays for the disposal of the waste and the operation of the Transfer Station.
- 4. The special bags are the only bags allowed in the compactor at the Transfer Station.
- 5. A FEE will be charged for large items (sofas, chairs, mattresses, etc.) that will not fit in a bag. The amount of the FEE will be determined by the Transfer Station Manager in accordance with the FEE SCHEDULE established by the Board of Selectmen.
- The price per bag will be set by the Selectmen and may change without notice as the volume of waste and/or disposal costs change.


