time of sticker purchase.


Transfer Station sticker must be on

## Mandatory Recycling

All mandatory recycling items must be placed in the designated areas. Materials all need to be clean, dry and free of other materials.

**Corrugated Cardboard** – clean & flattened

**Glass Containers** - (bottles, jars, drinking glasses) Lids must be removed.

**Other Glass Materials** - windows, porcelain, Pyrex, ceramics. Must be placed in designated bins.

**Computers and Electronics** – Includes microwaves. See Disposal Fees list.

**Mixed Paper** – newspaper, magazines, shredded paper, cereal boxes, food boxes (pasta, snack cakes, etc.), egg cartons, paper towel and toilet paper cylinders, soda and beer boxes, etc – please flatten all boxes

### The mandatory recycling policy shall be strictly enforced as follows:

- First offense shall result in a written warning.
- Second offense shall result in the suspension of Transfer Station privileges for a period of one week.
- Third offense shall result in the suspension of Transfer Station privileges for a period of three months.
- Fourth offense shall result in the suspension of Transfer Station for a period of one year.

## Voluntary Recycling

The Transfer Station staff encourages additional recycling of:

- Plastic Bottles & Jugs (PET #1 HDPE #2)
- Metal Cans (Aluminum & steel)
- Yard/Garden Waste
- Scrap Metal
- Motor Oil (in 1 gallon jugs)
- Car & Rechargeable Batteries

## Other Services

**Burn Pit** - Clean, unfinished/untreated wood only, including brush and tree limbs less than 5" in diameter. **NO** plywood, treated wood, chipboard or furniture allowed!

**Composting** - Leaves, pine needles, grass clippings and garden waste only. Finished compost available by backhoe bucket for purchase:

Full Bucket - \$10.00

3/4 Bucket - \$7.50

1/2 Bucket - \$ 5.00

1/4 Bucket - \$2.50

**Hazardous Household Waste** - Charlestown Transfer Station **does NOT accept hazardous waste**. For disposal, contact the City of Keene at 352-5739 or the Upper Valley Lake Sunapee Regional Planning Commission at 448-1680 for other options.

## Disposal Fees

- **Construction/Demolition Debris** - (Painted/treated wood, sheetrock, etc) \$0.065 per pound
- **Demo under 20 pounds** - \$2.00
- **Refrigerators, Freezers, Air Conditioners** - \$15.00 each
- **Car or Light Truck Tires with rim** - \$3.75 each
- **Car or Light Truck Tires without rim** - \$2.75 each
- **Heavy Truck & Tractor Tires (18"+)** - \$50.00
- **Fluorescent Light Tubes** - \$0.25 per foot
- **TV 19" or less** - \$2.00 each
- **TV larger than 19"** - \$0.065 per pound
- **Propane Tanks** - \$2.00 each
- **Helium Tanks** - \$5.00 each
- **Computers (CPU, monitor, keyboard)** - \$5.00 per piece or \$10.00 complete set \*\*
- **Microwave Ovens** - \$10.00 each \*\*
